The Government has decided that all offices of the State Government, PSUs, Autonomous Bodies, Organizations, local Self Government Institutions, Educational Institutions etc may organize reading of the Preamble to the Constitution of India on 26th November, 2023 at 1100 hrs from their respective offices/locations. Copy of the Preamble to the Constitution of India is also enclosed for ready reference.

3. The LR & Additional Secretary, Law Department is requested for taking necessary action to organize other activities including Talks/Webinars on constitutional values and fundamental principles of the Constitution of India on 26th November, 2023.



THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a ³[SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the ⁴[unity and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.
